

Minutes of the meeting of
East Tuddenham Parish Council
Held on Monday 12th April 2010 at
7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall

Present: Mrs Hickling, the full Council, the clerk and two members of the public.

Apologies: were received from District Councillor Mr. P. Claussen and County Councillor Mr. B. Borrett.

Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising: Mr. Anderson reported on the meeting in Honingham regarding the traffic problems due to the new roundabout. He said that the meeting was very well attended with all in agreement that this was an unacceptable problem. It was suggested that temporary traffic lights be placed at the roundabout and also a trial period of no right turns into Honingham and Church Lane. A group was being formed to keep a watching brief and Mr. Anderson agreed to be part of it. The clerk would again get in touch with the Highways Department especially about the state of Church Lane.

Finance: The clerk had finalised the end of year accounts and presented them to the Council. Mrs. Fane proposed and Mr. Guy seconded the adoption of the financial statement which was duly signed by the Chairman. A cheque for £115.85 for membership of the NALC was signed.

Planning: Five planning applications were discussed and the Councillors had no objection to any of them. They were:- the extension at Ailwyn Hall, the Low Cost Houses, a 2 storey extension in Bull Close, and extension to Old Hall and a rear extension at 45 Dereham Road.

Annual Meeting: This would be on Wednesday 19th May and the clerk would get in touch with all the relevant speakers. Mrs. Hickling would liaise with Flagship Housing and Breckland Council regarding a presentation of the low cost houses.

Any other business: The Village Fete would be held on 12th June and offers of help would be appreciated. Miss Leaney suggested that the minutes be put into a computer format so that they would be available to all. Miss Leaney said she would investigate whether the archive department at County Hall could help in this matter but Miss Barrett said that the old minutes books were best kept as they are as they were a record of the history of the village.
