

# **EAST TUDDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL**

## **Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 12<sup>th</sup> March 2012.**

The normal monthly meeting held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2012 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall.

Attendees: Ian Payter ( Chairman), Lynsay Barrett ( Vice Chair) , Anna-Marie High, Charles Barker and two members of the public.

Apologies for Absence: apologies were received from Ted Guy, Alex Leaney and Paul Claussen & Brian Rose ( District Councillors).

1. The Chair welcomed the members to the meeting.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting were agreed as a true record of the meeting and signed by the Chairman.
3. Matters arising from previous minutes :-

Dog Waste Bins – we have not yet approached the Village Hall Committee re. siting and possible cost sharing and this will be done as soon as possible.

We received an email from Highways following our letter to them regarding the junction on Mattishall Road and Berrys Lane and the complaint from Earthsea School following a recent serious road accident – Highways say they will look at improving the signs but they have restricted funds due to budget cuts – a copy was sent to Earthsea School .

Milestone – the milestone has been restored.

Church Grass Cutting – we are obtaining quotations to carry out this work and should be able to finalise this before the next meeting.

There were three new Planning applications and these were all discussed in detail – the two members of the public were there to discuss one application in particular – both sides of their arguments were aired and discussed.
