

Minutes of Parish Council Meeting 28th November 2011

EAST TUDDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL

The normal monthly meeting held on Monday 28th November 2011 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall.

Attendees: Ian Payter (Chairperson), Ted Guy, Charles Barker, Les Wood, Anna-Marie High, Alex Leaney, Lynsay Barrett, District Councillor Paul Claussen.

1. The Chair welcomed the members and District Councillor Claussen to the meeting.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting 17th October 2011 were acknowledged as a true record of the meeting and signed by the Chairperson.
3. **Minutes arising:**

The clerk stated that he had not yet received a plan for the tree planting scheme, the clerk said he had had a telephone call to say that they had been posted but as of this meeting none had been received. The councillors agreed that when the plans are received they would be discussed and a decision made.

The chair asked for an update from the clerk as to the progress of cost for dog bins for the village green, the clerk confirmed that although he had contacted the dog warden he had not heard from him. Mr Claussen stated to the meeting that Andrew Grimley at Breckland Council would be the person to contact and the clerk agreed to contact him to gain a quotation for the supply and erection of the bins and a cost for emptying them.

4. **Finance:** The chair asked the clerk if he was now an account holder for the parish account, the clerk confirmed he was.

The clerk stated that he had sent a letter to Margaret Cram to send an invoice to the Parish Council regarding payment for the Friendship club which the council had agreed to fund but as yet no invoice had been received. Councillor Barker said that he thought the agreement to fund this was to be placed in the Parish Pump and a discussion between councillors took place as to who the contact for

the group was. The clerk confirmed that he would place an article in the next pump once an invoice was received.

5. Planning:

Application: 20111496. Honingham Road, Weston Longville, NR9 5LB. Change of use to residential purposes, involving the sitting of two mobile caravans and development of 2 hard standings and internal access Road. (Broadland Council)

The clerk stated that this application was received by Broadland and that he was unable to have an extension to the time scale and therefore the response need to be sent by 8.12.2011.

The councillors examined the plans and had some concerns regarding the plans due to the large size of the plot of land bordering on to the planned building application and how this could be managed by the Council.

District Councillor stated that the planning permission would have an effect on some of the parish residents and said that a wording suitable would be to say that the Parish Council ask Broadland to be minded to manage and control the site. This was agreed by the councillors.

Application: 3PL/2011/1142/F. Demolition of existing dwelling and erection of 5 dwellings at The Baynings, East Tuddenham.

The councillors discussed the application in detail and it was noted that this application was within the development boundary as part of the LDF and that the applicant had released land for the building of affordable housing within the village. The councillors agreed that they would not object the development but wished it to be noted that the village had no amenities and that they had concerns regarding to traffic issues within the village in general and to this section of road in particular.

The clerk brought the meetings attention that the farm house in Common Road had now been demolished and no further action was needed from Breckland Council.

- 6.** The clerk confirmed that the Norfolk Constabulary had sent the crime figures for 01.10.11 to 31.10.11 and no crimes had been reported for East Tuddenham.

It was noted that the Parish Council application has not been successful on this occasion, but that the parish was added to the SAM2 and that the parish should see the temporary sign put up over the next few months.
