

Minutes of the meeting of

Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were read, confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising: Mr. Rose stated that there had been no interest in a meeting to discuss the village Clusters. Mrs. Hickling said that the Ladies' Evening in the Village Hall went very well and there would be another one on 18<sup>th</sup> August, however there had been no time to organize the Community Lunch.

Finance: The clerk reported that there was £3,229.20 in the bank account and the Parish Council was allowed to make a donation to the school at Earthsea House for their community project. Following a discussion it was decided to donate £250 to the purchase of new goal posts. This sum was proposed by Mrs. Fane and seconded by Miss Leaney with all in agreement,

Planning: An application had been received for the erection of a conservatory at Newham, Common Road and Mrs. Shrimpling left the meeting at this juncture. The Council had no objection to this application going ahead.

Roads: The new roundabout was to be called the Honingham roundabout and this was still causing problems at rush hour times. SAM had again monitored speeding in the village, however this was not done at peak times so did not really show the true picture. The clerk would get in touch with the Highways Dept. regarding the poor state of the footpath between the Church and Berry's Lane and also mention the dangerous condition of Church Lane. Flooding had been reported in another part of Tilney Close. The fact that the Village Green should be all grass was discussed and it was decided that the Councillors do a recce and then decide on what ought to be done. Breckland Council to be asked to clear the undergrowth at the lay by.

Community Cohesion: The Chairman reported that four Councillors and the clerk attended the evening at Rasputin's Restaurant in Swaffham when talks were given by the police, an agricultural labour agent, the owner of the restaurant and members of the Council.

Any Other Business: The provision of a new notice board was discussed and it was decided first to see if the Village Hall Committee wished to share one and also to get estimates. The siting of the board was also discussed and the Chairman would ask whether it could be placed on the new wall at the corner of Common Road. The Village Green, adjacent to the bus stop, was also proposed. Crime statistics showed that there had been a small amount of vandalism in the village.
