

**East Tuddenham Parish Council**  
**Minutes of the Meeting held 13<sup>th</sup> February 2017**

**(The meeting opened at 7.35pm in the Village Hall)**

1. The minutes of the meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> January were approved and duly signed.

**2. Matters arising from those minutes**

- The replacement play equipment for the children's play area has been ordered and two more items are due to arrive. A group of people have been organised to install the play equipment and it should be ready for Easter.
- IP confirmed that the new dual bin for dog waste and general waste has been put in situ and cemented in on Church Lane opposite Rotten Row.
- The proposal for the Honingham Food Hub is at consultation stage which will continue for a good while. The PC have been copied in on email objections thus far and there are various issues being raised. It was commented that there are hundreds of new houses due to be built in Easton and in Dereham which will compound the traffic increase.
- IP reassured the PC that he will make sure the Charities follow the process for making sure one member resigns and for that position to then be advertised, interviewed and assigned by the PC.

**3. Finance:**

- The following cheques were signed:
  - Breckland – Dual bin - £298.64
  - Ian Payter – Noticeboard - £500.00

**4. Planning:**

- 3PL/2016/1552/F – Hill House, Park Lane, Hockering – 14 residential dwellings – The PC submitted comments detailing concerns regarding increased traffic, lack of affordable housing and lack of local amenities. All comments made online raise issues and questions.
- 3PL/2016/1474/F – Centaur, Church Lane - conversion and extension – Amendments have been made to this application but no decision has been officially released.
- 3PL/2016/1348/F – Ailwyn Hall, Berrys Lane – extension and alterations to care home - confirmation has been received that this is approved
- 3PL/2017/0028/HOU – Rear extension and roof space Mattishall Road, Linden Lea – confirmation has been received that this is approved
- 3PL/2017/0067/HOU – Extension to dwelling – Tollgate Barns, Mattishall Road – The PC agreed they have no objections.

**5. Correspondence**

- Jobs for the Highway Rangers need to be submitted by 2<sup>nd</sup> March. The pot holes on Mattishall Road have been rectified as well as issues near the bus stop. Pot holes near Mock Beggar Hall and on Rotten Row are still yet to be done but Rotten Row has been given a job number after IP reported it.
- Mattishall PC have submitted their Neighbourhood Plan and supporting documents for consultation from 2<sup>nd</sup> February to 15<sup>th</sup> March. This is the second opportunity to make comments on these documents which are available on the Breckland website.
- The first Norwich Western Link local working group meeting will take place on Tues 21<sup>st</sup> February at the

*Hall for All in Weston Longville. This was noted by the PC but there are no councillors available to attend.*

#### **6. Updates from Councillors**

- *IP gave good news that the noticeboard is finished for Rotten Row/Church Lane. AL offered to organise getting this erected and AH will provide some equipment to assist. A suggestion was made for it to be put opposite the dog bin. The cost of this board was £500.*
- *IP advised of a three part offshore wind farm project at Hornsea. There are energy meetings scheduled which will be put up on the village noticeboards.*
- *SM advised of a power outage to a property near to her. Parking has not been advised on the pavement outside the house as the electrics are only 2ft underneath.*
