**1. The minutes of the meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> April were approved and duly signed.**

**2. Matters arising from those minutes**

- The last bill has been received for the climbing net. The equipment has all been installed. The Village Hall will be paying back the 20% VAT to the PC.

- The pot holes in the village are gradually being filled and Highways seem to be progressing them well. It was reiterated that Highways won't know about pot holes unless people contact them. The road may be resurfaced if there are enough of them..
