Minutes of the Meeting held 9th June 2014

1. The minutes of the meeting held on 12th May 2014 were approved and duly signed.

2. Matters arising from those minutes:

- *No progress re the white line rectification in front of the houses along Mattishall Road (West). IP is waiting for a new appointment to be arranged.*
- *IP will advise of the speed traffic sensor activity on his return from holiday and relay to members at the next Parish Council meeting.*
- *The new Toddler group 'Tuddenham Tots' is slowly gaining more new families.*
- *It has been confirmed that the remit of the charity land at Rotten Row/Church Lane includes a legal cycle for grazing cattle for a specified period of time. The land is cordoned off whilst being grazed to keep it safe and to keep the path open for walkers. This ensures the vegetation growth is under control and remains tidy and short ready for Spring. The use of the land has to be proved in order for the farmer to get a government contribution.*

5. Correspondence:

- *The trees at the Beeches on Common Road have had a temporary TPO placed on them. Members agreed that they need a permanent TPO. IP to check the situation on a permanent TPO. A MoP (neighbour) advised that an independent survey has been carried out on the remaining trees to ensure they are healthy, mature trees and not diseased. CC will check with IP whether a request was made for the felled trees to be replaced with new established trees. A temporary fence has been put in place splitting the land surrounding the property in two so that the property is now for sale with the land as a separate plot.*

- *AH has received correspondence following the Parish Assembly regarding whether a congratulatory letter was sent by IP to Mary Blathwayt for Easton School. CC will check this with IP.*
- *A concern has been raised regarding the long grass lining the footpath between the church down to the wood, which has become impassable. This may be highways responsibility. LB will check.*
