

**East Tuddenham Parish Council**  
**Minutes of the Meeting held 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

1. The minutes of the meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> January were approved and duly signed.

2. **Matters arising from those minutes**

- There are no new updates regarding the A47 improvements. LB commented that Highways visited a school recently to liaise regarding comments received about the A47 improvements and to ask for a contact. This was regarded by the PC as positive communication that Highways are taking views and comments into account.
- It was fed back that the issues for Highways Rangers to attend to in the village have not yet been completed. These are: The drain on the Church footpath is completely covered and blocked by debris from cuttings. Also on Church Lane near the water bore hole, there is a large pile of soil has been dumped which contains glass and piping. SM will report the large pile of soil to Breckland.
- The defibrillator for the Village Hall has been installed. CB contacted Mattishall Parish Council who have two demonstrations a year on training. They have extended this invite to anyone in East Tuddenham who would like to attend. Once the dates have been confirmed, they will be published. CB to advise.
- There are currently no further updates on obtaining a survey template from Flagship/Brown & Co to issue to parishioners to prove the need for affordable housing. Paul Claussen suggested contacting Breckland Council for a survey template and would like to be kept informed of our ongoing progress. It was acknowledged that getting affordable housing built will be a lengthy process.
- There is no further news on getting a dog bin on Common Road at the bend outside Mock Beggar Hall. IP to advise at the next meeting.
- IP has not received a reply from Highways to see what can be changed about the lay-by on the main Mattishall Road near the Barnham Broom Crossroads to try and stop the issue of fly-tipping. There is still fly-tipping taking place.

- *It was commented that the gravel access to the village hall on entrance and exit to the car park is full of holes and is very uneven. The brick pillars at the bottom of the car park to the field have also been knocked down. LB will report this to the village hall committee.*
- *SM would like to put in a request to Highways for a sign on the Barnham Broom Road to signal an upcoming road to the right for Common Road. This will be put forward.*
- *SM spoke of an issue at the same junction. There is an overgrown hedge on either side of the Common Road T Junction onto Barnham Broom Road which is obscuring the view for drivers pulling out of this junction. CC will report this to the Highway Rangers.*
- *SM wanted to remind the Parish Council and parishioners that the mobile library is available to use. The dates and times of its visits to East Tuddenham are published in the Parish Pump.*
