Minutes of the Meeting held 10th February 2020

1. The minutes of the meeting held on 13th January were approved and duly signed.

2. Matters arising from those minutes

- *Highways Rangers Tasks: - all the reported tasks have been completed.*
- *IP has been liaising with Breckland regarding affordable housing in the village. This is classed as “An Exception Site”. Four different Housing Associations are keen on taking this forward so IP and AH will meet and make a choice. They are all aware of the proposed size of the site and it's most likely there will be a mixture of properties for people connected to the village.*
- *IP received a land map from East Tuddenham Charities which assists greatly to identify who owns various parcels of land in the village.*
- *Two meetings with Highways took place before Christmas regarding the A47 North Tuddenham to Easton Dualling Improvements, including one in East Tuddenham and also a multi parish meeting.*

Highways England (HE) are hosting a Public Meeting on Monday 2nd March 2020 in the Village Hall between 1pm and 8pm. HE will have a team available and there will also be information boards, feedback forms and a brochure to view and make comments. It is suggested that villagers should attend this important meeting.

- *Charles Barker has officially resigned from the Parish Council, therefore there is a space on the Parish Council for a new member to join.*
- *Hall Lane street name plate – a new plate will be erected on the green facing traffic from Norwich.*
